Código Não Binário works at the intersection of technology and gender, strengthening LGBTQIA+ people and collectives in the defense of digital and human rights.

It was founded on more than 15 years of activism by its co-founders in human rights, feminism, LGBTQIA+ advocacy, and open technologies.

The Entre Amigues podcast was one of our first collective creations — a loud echo of the experience and resistance that shaped us.

We now channel this history into innovation: combining strategic litigation, open-source technology, activism-oriented AI and digital justice work.

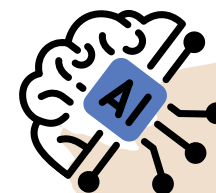
9 episodes, millions of views, and a powerful network of queer voices across Brazil.



The Collective Response

Supported by national and international rapid response funds, we provided legal and psychological aid to those affected.

We also held public dialogues at the Museum of Sexual Diversity in Sao Paulo, addressing gender, race, sexuality, digital rights and collective care.



The Strategic Turn and the Future

From those actions, we built a **Class Action Lawsuit** (ACP) with four organizations against Big Techs — Google, Meta, TikTok, and X.

Our data evolved into the **first LGBTQIA+ hate dataset** and **the first open AI model** to identify hate speech online in Portuguese in the world.



The Hate Wave

Coordinated attacks led by far-right figures spread rapidly across platforms, boosted by algorithmic recommendation systems.

The lack of moderation and safety measures allowed hate speech to thrive, turning platforms into enablers of gender-based violence.

The Treasure of Data

We built a comprehensive map of the Hate Wave, collected data and legal evidence and realized this was bigger than ourselves.

- Amplify counter-narratives through creative communication
